

Timeline for Land Justice Futures Preparation for November 23 Zoom Session

During the August 2024 Leadership Webcast last night, Sisters Gemma Doll and Susan Leslie spoke about our congregation's engagement with *Land Justice Futures (LJF)*, formerly known as *the Nuns & Nones Land Justice Project*. In preparation for our daylong Zoom Formation and Information session with the LJF team scheduled for Saturday, November 23, 2024, we have been asked to view 3 videos, each approximately 1 hour in length. The link for each video will be accompanied by a link for related printed material. We encourage you to consider viewing these videos, and discussing the content and materials with others, if possible.

The timeline for all of this follows:

August 26, 2024 – send link for the video, "Introduction to Land Justice" by Sarah Bradley. We are trying to get a written transcript of the video. If we succeed, we will send that out later.

September 4, 2024 – resend the August 23 links

September 25, 2024 – send links for the video, "Historic Reckoning", and written material, "Confronting the Doctrine of Discovery". This handout includes a suggested group process. But even if you watch it alone, there are some good materials for personal reflection in the handout.

October 9, 2024 – resend the September 25 links

October 23, 2024 – send links for the video report about our Heartland Farmland by Attorney Jessica Intermill, and for the written material, "Dominican Sisters of Peace, Heartland Farm, Kansas: European Treatment of Rush County".

November 6, 2024 – resend the October 23 links.

Early to mid-November – send out registration request for the November 23 Zoom event.

November 23, 2024 – Daylong Formation/Information Zoom Gathering with members of the Land Justice Futures Team.

June 13, 2025 – In-person session with members of the Land Justice Futures Team during our June 13-15 Community Days. This will be live streamed for those unable to attend in person.
